



Police & Crime Update – Crime Update circulated to PC's. Clerk to publish on Parish Council Facebook page: Clerk has been in touch with NYCC to enquire about creating a safer passing point over the Northallerton Road opposite the Croft Hotel. We are looking into some form of crossing, warning signs/lights. Cllr Kennedy expressed concern at the school children that are regularly crossing the road and the dangers speeding traffic poses to them. Clerk to update at the next meeting

Additional Croft-on-Tees Village signs update – Chairman has been in contact with North Yorkshire Highways to get approval for a sign to be installed on the middle lamppost over the Croft Bridge. Waiting to hear back from NYCC to then progress with ordering of the sign.

Second Dog Bin Install at Clowbeck - this is going ahead. Clerk to check progress with RDC

PRECEPT 2019/20 – this was discussed with the PC's. Working through the 2019/20 Budget the Precept request was agreed at £3261.21. Clerk to inform RDC

AOB; A Parishioner contacted the Clerk requesting whether an additional Dog Bin could be installed on Rectory Lane following problems with dog owners putting dog waste in their bin and the Refuse Collectors claiming it should not be going in that bin. (Clerk to clarify this with RDC) PC's agreed that there were sufficient Dog Bins in and around the Village at the moment but that a plan should be designed showing where the existing Dog Bins were around the village and put up at certain hotspots.
