As a way of saying thank you to all the people who kindly helped to raise funds for the new hall, we are holding a party on the evening, from 7:30 until late!


There will be Music, Indian Food and a Disco so we can dance the night away!




With the new hall comes more space, a brand spanking new projector and sound system, but the same guaranteed fun filled evening for all members of the family!

Remembrance Service at Dalton War Memorial on Sunday, November 10 at 12 noon.


